



CAHC Jamboree Rules 2017-2018

General:

- This is a USA Hockey sanctioned 6U and 8U tournament and all USA Hockey rules will apply unless otherwise noted below.
- The tournament will begin and end play according to the schedule designated by the tournament committee.
- Teams need to be ready to play 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to amend these rules as it deems necessary.
- In the event of an injury or sickness, the tournament hosts, sponsors, officials or anyone else involved with the tournament SHALL NOT BE LIABLE.

Registration and Credentials:

- Credentials will be checked prior to each team's first game and may be checked at any time during the tournament.
- All players must be USA Hockey registered and all players must be listed on the team's official USA Hockey roster.
- All registration fees must be paid by the deadline date designated by the Tournament Director.

Game details:

- 6U teams will play cross-ice games. 8U teams will play ½ ice games.
- USA Hockey Rules will apply, except as modified below:
 - 6U games will be two 30 minute run clock periods with a 2-minute break between periods. 6U games will typically be played 4 vs. 4.
 - 8U games will be three 12 minute run clock periods with one minute between periods. A 4-minute warm up will be allowed prior to each game. 8U Games will be played 4 vs. 4 with a goalie. Goalie equipment must be used.
 - Clock will be a running clock for the entire game. Buzzer will sound every 2 minutes for line changes for 6U and 8U.
 - After a goal or penalty, the puck shall be put into play without a face off.
- Penalties (8U): A penalized player will sit the remainder of shift. If a penalty is at the end of shift, the player shall sit the next shift. A player off the bench will be allowed to replace the penalized player.

Tournament play:

- These games are intended for fun, ice time experience for the players and general overall development of hockey skills. No score will be kept. There will be no overtime periods.
- Officiating: 6U will not have officials with each team being responsible for having a coach available to assist on the ice for each game. 8U will have officials on the ice.
- A blue game puck will be provided.

Discipline:

- Should any player(s) or any team(s) willfully damage property in the facilities or rink, all costs for repairs or replacement shall be borne by the team(s) concerned. Arrangements for restitution shall be made immediately with the rink management.
- Infractions of above rules will be given to the Tournament Director for a ruling for possible disqualifications from the tournament.

Awards:

Team awards and individual awards will be given as designated by the tournament committee.
